# 2023-24 Dress Code Policy UNIFORM POLICY (Mondays - *Wednesdays) 

## TOPS:

Polo collared shirt (any SOLID color with $2-5$ buttons)
Shirts may be short or long-sleeved (NOT sleeveless)
Shirt length must be at the hips (NOT the waist)

## BOTTOMS:

BOYS/GIRLS:
BLACK/KHAKI (light tan) color pants, capris, and jeans
BLACK/KHAKI (light tan) color shorts/skorts (no more than 2 inches above the knee)
(Shades of dark brown, mustard, pink, orange, and blue colors are NOT acceptable)

## FOOTWEAR:

Dress shoes, casual shoes, boots, sneakers, and sandals with straps around the ankle

## HAIR:

*BOYS:
Hair color should be a color that can be grown naturally. Brown, blonde(dirty), and black are considered natural hair colors. NO hair extensions, weaves, or wigs are permitted.

## *GIRLS:

Hair color should be a color that can be grown naturally. Brown, blonde(dirty), and black are considered natural hair colors.

## PIERCINGS:

*BOYS:
ALL piercings must be removed each school day BEFORE ENTERING THE BUILDING.

## GIRLS:

*May have a maximum of TWO (2) piercings in the OUTER ear lobes ONLY (no other place on or in the ear including rod piercings).
*May have ONE (1) SMALL STUD NOSE PIERCING (no other piercings in the nose will be acceptable) All other piercings must be removed before school each day BEFORE ENTERING THE BUILDING.
*NO OTHER PIERCINGS ARE PERMITTED EXCEPT THOSE LISTED ABOVE!
BOYS/GIRLS (general information):
NO cargo jeans/pants/shorts/capris (jeans/pants/shorts/capris with side pockets), spandex, stretch, corduroy, or low-rise jeans/pants/shorts/capris
NO slippers, flip-flops, slides/mules, and sneakers with wheels
NO head coverings or scarves (unless a hat during winter months or for religious purposes)

## DRESS DOWN POLICY *(Thursdays or the last day for the week)

Students have the option to wear casual clothing. The footwear, hair, and piercings policy above still apply.
Below is a short but not complete list of UNA CCEPTABLE CLOTHING:

Shirts with an INAPPROPRIATE pattern, writing, or airbrush detail
Sleeveless Shirts that have less than 3 inches on the shoulders
Ripped/Torn Clothing (including bottoms and tops even if material is under the hole)
Outerwear worn as a shirt
Leggings/Jeggings
Pajama style bottoms or tops
Jeans/Pants/Capris/Shorts that are made of MAINLY spandex, stretch, or corduroy material
Shorts/Dresses/Skirts/Skorts that are more than 2 inches above the knee
Head Coverings or scarves (unless a hat during winter months or for religious purposes)

All clothing must be properly sized and worn modestly.
THE SCHOOL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY APPAREL WORN bY A STUDENT IF THE STYLES, STANDARD, COLOR, ETC. DO NOT CONFORM.
